

MOVE-IN GUIDE

Welcome to the neighborhood.

Livermore Sanitation is your Recyclables, Organics, and Garbage collector and we need your help to reduce waste and conserve resources. Please use the tips and resources listed here.

DON'T TRASH YOUR PACKING MATERIALS!

- Ask your property manager if another resident is moving and would like them.
- Contact mailing centers (such as UPS and Mail Boxes Etc.) and moving companies (like U-Haul) to see what packing materials they may accept for donation.
- Flatten unwanted boxes and place in the blue cart/bin along with any packing paper.

Unwanted household goods? If they're still in good condition, choose to sell or donate instead of dispose. Try using one of these resources:

Also consider working with a nearby consignment shop, or donating to a favorite church or charity.

REDUCE: Choose durable and reusable products instead of single-use disposable options. Buy in bulk or select products with less packaging.

REUSE: Refurbish and repair items that are worthwhile. Sell or donate unwanted items that are still in good condition, don't dispose.

RECYCLE: Place appropriate items in your **Recyclables** cart/bin. They'll be made into new products.

ROT: Put food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings in your **Organics** cart/bin. They'll be turned into compost.

Ask your property manager for a **FREE** bag to collect and transport your recyclables.



Items that are no longer usable can be placed in your **Recyclables** or **Garbage** cart/bin. Please sort correctly. To arrange for collection of large items, ask your property manager to contact Livermore Sanitation.

PUT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE IN ITS PLACE. Items like pesticides, fertilizers, paint/varnish, toxic cleaning products, mercury-containing items (thermometers, fluorescent lights, etc.), unwanted medications, and sharps (needles and lances) need to be taken to a hazardous waste collection facility.
