Contact Livermore Sanitation to schedule your On-Call Cleanup for overflow garbage and a large appliance or e-waste item. Residents of single-family homes are entitled to three On-Call Cleanups every 12 months at no additional charge. Bulky items like mattresses, sofas, and bookshelves can also be collected for a nominal charge.

## **Need to Dispose of Hazardous Waste?**

### **EXPANDED HOURS MAKE FREE DROP-OFF EVEN EASIER!**

The County's household hazardous waste facility at 5584 La Ribera Street is now open Fridays from 9am to 2:30pm and Saturdays from 9am to 4pm. Livermore residents can drop-off the following unwanted hazardous items for no charge:

**PAINT** - stain, shellac, solvents, thinners, additives, oil & latex paint

**AUTO** - fuel, waxes, batteries, additives, motor oil/filters, antifreeze

**GARDEN** - sprays, fertilizers, ant traps, pesticides, herbicides, rat poison, gopher bait


**ADHESIVES** - putty, caulk, epoxy, mortar, stucco, uncured cement powder, wood glue


**ELECTRONICS** - TVs, computers, phones, stereo equipment, microwaves, thermostats, & more

**MISCELLANEOUS** - fluorescent bulbs, household batteries, needles & other sharps, most medications, propane, & more


