- Check your driveway or regular parking area for build-up of auto fluids. If your car is leaking, place a drip pan under your car, and then promptly take it to a professional repair shop.
- Have your oil changed regularly. The longer engine oil is in service, the thinner it gets and the more likely it is to leak.



- Contain used oil and used oil filters properly. If you change your own oil, contact us for details regarding our free used oil/filter collection program.

Not Ready to Take Down Your Christmas Tree?

Livermore Sanitation's special holiday tree collection service ends on January 17th. However, you can still get your tree composted through our curbside collection program!

- Remove all decorations, lights, and the stand from your tree.
- Cut your tree into small sections and place it in your **Organics** cart, make sure the lid fully closes.
- Remember that flocked and artificial trees cannot be composted and belong in your **Garbage** cart.
- Call us at 925-449-7300 if your tree is too big to dispose of in the appropriate cart. We are happy to help you make other arrangements!

Start the new year knowing your family and your home are protected by smoke detectors and carbon monoxide alarms that work.

- Test existing detectors and alarms.
- Put in new batteries and recycle the old ones. Put spent batteries in a clear zipper-lock bag and place on top of your **Recyclables** cart on collection day.
- Remove non-working detectors and alarms and install new ones.
- Dispose of non-working detectors and alarms responsibly. Refer to the product label, user's manual, or warranty for manufacturer's instructions.
