STAY CLEAR OF CLOGS

Fats, oils and grease (FOG) clog drains and sewer pipes.

Protect your home by managing FOG properly.

- For small amounts of FOG, scrape out or use paper towels to wipe your pans, and then place the FOG or soiled paper towels in your Food Scrap pail or green **Organics** cart.

- For large amounts of FOG, such as used oil from a turkey fryer, collect cooled oil in a sealable container and take it to the Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Facility in Livermore. Limits apply. Please visit www.StopWaste.Org/hhw or call **1-800-606-6606** for more information.
