Corrugated cardboard & paper boxes - *Large or multiple pieces should be flattened and/or cut*
Catalogs, phonebooks & magazines
Newspaper & junk mail
Dairy cartons
Shredded paper
Aseptic boxes - *Juice, soup & soy milk*

Glass Bottles & Jars

Aluminum & Metal

Aerosol cans (*completely empty*)
Food & beverage cans
Pots & pans

Plastics Labeled through

Bottles, jars, tubs & trays



REMEMBER: No food-soiled paper!
